ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES**Public Service Vehicles (Construction) (Amendment)
Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1988**

Made 14th September 1988

Coming into operation 24th October 1988

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 66(1)(d) and 218(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Service Vehicles (Construction) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1988 and shall come into operation on 24th October 1988.

Regulations amended

2. In regulation 77 of the Public Service Vehicles (Construction) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1960(b) delete the words from "Accommodation" to the end.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Public Service Vehicles (Construction) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1960 by removing the requirement that accommodation for luggage must be provided on the roof of a taxi used to stand or ply for hire in the City of Belfast. The provision of a fixed roof guard rail for luggage is now optional on such vehicles.
