**One-Way Traffic (Belfast) (Amendment) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1988***Made* 11th February 1988*Coming into operation* 27th March 1988

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the One-Way Traffic (Belfast) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1988 and shall come into operation on 27th March 1988.

Amendment

2. Schedule 2 to the One-Way Traffic (Belfast) Order (Northern Ireland) 1986(b) shall be amended by:—

- (1) the deletion of the items relating to Smithfield Square North and Smithfield Square South;
- (2) the addition of the following item:—

Column 1	Column 2
Smithfield Square North	Westerly from Gresham Street to Winetavern Street

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the provisions of the One-Way Traffic (Belfast) Order (Northern Ireland) 1986.

The amendment provides for the re-introduction of two-way traffic in Smithfield Square South, and part of Smithfield Square North and for the introduction of a one-way system of traffic in Smithfield Square North, from Gresham Street to Winetavern Street, Belfast.
