ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES**Off-Street Parking (Amendment) Bye-Laws
(Northern Ireland) 1988**

Made 11th February 1988

Coming into operation 1st March 1988

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 105(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, makes the following bye-laws:—

Citation and commencement

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Off-Street Parking (Amendment) Bye-Laws (Northern Ireland) 1988 and shall come into operation on 1st March 1988.

Amendment

2. The Off-Street Parking Bye-Laws (Northern Ireland) 1983(b) shall be amended by the substitution for item 315 in Part I of the Schedule of the item in the Schedule to these bye-laws.
