Nursing Homes (Registration Fees and Lasers Control) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1988

Made 2nd November 1988

Coming into operation . . . 12th December 1988

The Department of Health and Social Services in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 1(2) and 6(1)(e) of the Nursing Homes and Nursing Agencies Act (Northern Ireland) 1971(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Nursing Homes (Registration Fees and Lasers Control) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1988 and shall come into operation on 12th December 1988.

Amendment

- 2. The Nursing Homes (Registration Fees and Lasers Control) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1986(b) shall be amended as follows—
 - (a) after regulation 1 there shall be inserted the following regulation—"Interpretation
 - 1A. In these regulations "manager" means the person registered in respect of a nursing home under Part I of the Nursing Homes and Nursing Agencies Act (Northern Ireland) 1971.";
 - (b) in regulation 2(1) for "£550." there shall be substituted "£600."; and
 - (c) in regulation 2(2) for "£350." there shall be substituted "£380.".

Nursing Homes

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations amend regulation 2 of the Nursing Homes (Registration Fees and Lasers Control) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1986 so as to increase the fees, associated with the registration of nursing homes, payable to a Health and Social Services Board.

The fee to accompany an application for registration is increased from £550 to £600. The fee to accompany such an application on a proposed change of manager, where there are no other changes in relation to the home, is increased from £350 to £380. Manager is defined as the person registered in respect of a nursing home.
