**The Planning (Amendment) (1978 Order) (Commencement)
Order (Northern Ireland) 1988**

Made *11th January 1988*

The Department of the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 1(2) of the Planning (Amendment) (Northern Ireland) Order 1978(a) and paragraph 2(1) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Planning (Amendment) (1978 Order) (Commencement) Order (Northern Ireland) 1988.

2. The day appointed for the coming into operation of Article 4(c) of the Planning (Amendment) (Northern Ireland) Order 1978 shall be 1st March 1988.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings into operation on 1st March 1988 Article 4 of the Planning (Amendment) (Northern Ireland) Order 1978 which prohibits the demolition of certain buildings in conservation areas without the consent of the Department of the Environment.
