Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions (Purchase of Increased Benefits) (Amendment) Regulations 1988

Made 7th December 1988

Coming into operation 1st January 1989

To be laid before Parliament

The Secretary of State, in pursuance of section 25 of the Police Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a), read with Articles 14 and 15 of the Superannuation (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(b), and after consulting, in accordance with section 34(2) of the said Act of 1970, the Police Authority for Northern Ireland and the Police Association for Northern Ireland, and, in accordance with section 2(3) of the Police Negotiating Board Act 1980(c), the Police Negotiating Board for the United Kingdom, hereby, with the concurrence of the Treasury, makes the following regulations:—

Citation, commencement and effect

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions (Purchase of Increased Benefits) (Amendment) Regulations 1988.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on 1st January 1989 and shall have effect as from 1st February 1988.

Interpretation

2. In regulation 2(1)(a) of the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions (Purchase of Increased Benefits) Regulations 1988(d) after the words “1988” there shall be inserted the following words “always provided that in relation to any period before 1st January 1989 any such reference shall be construed as a reference to the corresponding provision of the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions Regulations 1973(e)”.
