The Foyle Fisheries Commission, in exercise of its powers under section 13(1) and (2) of the Foyle Fisheries Act 1952(a) and section 13(1) and (2) of the Foyle Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland) 1952(b) with the approval of the Minister for the Marine in the Republic of Ireland (c) and of the Department of Agriculture for Northern Ireland(d) hereby makes the following Regulations:----

#### Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Foyle Area (Licensing of Fishing) Engines) (Amendment) Regulations 1989 and shall come into operation on 31st January 1989.
