Dental Charges (Amendment) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1989

Made 16th January 1989

Coming into operation 16th January 1989

The Department of Health and Social Services in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 98, 106 and 107 of and Schedule 15 to the Health and Personal Social Services (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, with the approval of the Department of Finance and Personnel(b), hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Dental Charges (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1989 and shall come into operation on 16th January 1989.

(2) In these regulations, “the principal regulations” means the Dental Charges Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1988(c).

Amendment of the principal regulations

2. In regulation 3 of the principal regulations—

(a) sub-paragraph (3)(d) shall be omitted;

(b) the existing sub-paragraphs (3)(e), (3)(f) and (3)(g) shall be renumbered as (3)(d), 3(e) and 3(f) respectively.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations amend the Dental Charges Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1988 which relate to charges in respect of the supply of dental appliances and dental treatment.

These regulations remove from the list of general dental services which are provided free of charge the clinical examination of a patient or any report thereon.

The Dental Charges (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1988, (S.R. 1988 No. 427), purported to be made in exercise of powers conferred by Schedule 15 to the Health and Personal Social Services (Northern Ireland) Order 1972, are null and void.
