Supreme Court Fees (Amendment) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1989*Made* 4th April 1989*Coming into operation* 10th April 1989

The Lord Chancellor, after consultation with the Lord Chief Justice and with the concurrence of the Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 116(1) of the Judicature (Northern Ireland) Act 1978(a) hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Supreme Court Fees (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1989 and shall come into operation on 10th April 1989.

2. In section 5 of the Schedule to the Supreme Court Fees Order (Northern Ireland) 1984(b) there shall be inserted, after Item 33, the new fees set out in the Schedule hereto.
