**LAGANSIDE DEVELOPMENT****The Laganside Development Designation Order  
(Northern Ireland) 1989**

*Made* . . . . . 10th April 1989

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 16th May 1989

The Department of the Environment, (in this order referred to as “the Department”) in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 3(1) and (5) of the Laganside Development (Northern Ireland) Order 1989(a), and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. This order may be cited as the Laganside Development Designation Order (Northern Ireland) 1989 and shall come into operation on 16th May 1989.

*Area Designated*

2.—(1) The area shown on the deposited map is hereby designated for the purposes of the Laganside Development (Northern Ireland) Order 1989.

(2) The boundaries of the designated area are shown on the deposited map by a red line and extend to the outside of that line.

(3) In this Article “the deposited map” means the map prepared in duplicate marked “Map referred to in the Laganside Development Designation Order (Northern Ireland) 1989” and signed by an Assistant Secretary in the Department, one duplicate of which is available for inspection at the office of the Department known as the Belfast Development Office, Clarendon House, 9-21 Adelaide Street, Belfast, and the other duplicate of which is available for inspection at the office of Laganside Ltd, Hurst House, Corporation Square, Belfast.
