**Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 1989**

*Made* . . . . . 20th April 1989

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 1st May 1989

*To be laid before Parliament*

The Secretary of State, in pursuance of section 25 of the Police Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a), and after consulting, in accordance with section 34(2) of the said Act of 1970, the Police Authority and the Police Association and, in accordance with section 2(3) of the Police Negotiating Board Act 1980(b), the Police Negotiating Board for the United Kingdom, hereby, with the concurrence of the Treasury, makes the following regulations:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. These regulations may be cited as the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 1989 and shall come into operation on 1st May 1989.

*Revocation*

2. The Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions (Amendment) Regulations 1989(c) are hereby revoked.
