## POLICE

**Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Full-Time)  
(Appointment and Conditions of Service)  
(Amendment) Regulations 1989**

*Made* . . . . . 6th June 1989

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 1st July 1989

*To be laid before Parliament*

The Secretary of State, in pursuance of section 26 of the Police Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a), read with section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962(b), and after consulting, in accordance with section 34(2) of the said Act of 1970, the Police Authority and the Police Association, hereby with the concurrence of Treasury makes the following regulations:—

*Citation, commencement and effect*

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Full-Time) (Appointment and Conditions of Service) (Amendment) Regulations 1989.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on 1st July 1989 and shall have effect for the purposes of regulations 4 and 5 as from 1st September 1988.

*Interpretation*

2. In these regulations any reference to the principal regulations is a reference to the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Full-Time) (Appointment and Conditions of Service) Regulations 1988(c).

*Contents of personal records*

3. In regulation 16(2) of the principal regulations the words “, if the member so requests” shall be omitted and there shall be inserted at the end, but not as part of paragraph (ii) of the proviso, the words “but in the case of a period free from punishment other than a caution which expires before 1st July 1989 only if the member so requests.”.

*Pay*

4.—(1) In Schedule 3 to the principal regulations for the Table there shall be substituted the Table set out in the Schedule.

(2) After paragraph 1 of Schedule 3 to the principal regulations there shall be inserted the following paragraph:—

“1A. In the case of a reserve constable who first became a member on or before 31st August 1988 his annual pay during the period before he completes 1 year of reckonable service shall be £8,352.”:

*Dog handler's allowance*

5. In Schedule 9 to the principal regulations in paragraph 1(i) for “£612” there shall be substituted “£663”.

*Meanings assigned to certain expressions, etc.*

6. In regulation 3 of the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Full-Time) (Appointment and Conditions of Service) (Amendment) Regulations 1988(a) for the words “regulation 4(1)” there shall be substituted the words “regulation 3(1)”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These regulations amend the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Full-Time) (Appointment and Conditions of Service) Regulations 1988 (the principal regulations) with effect, as provided by regulation 1, for the purposes of regulations 4 and 5 as from 1st September 1988.

Retrospection is authorised by section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962.

Regulation 3 provides for records of punishments to be removed from a member's personal record at the expiration of a specified period automatically instead of at the officer's request where the specified period ends on or after 1st July 1989.

Regulation 4 increases the rates of pay for members of the force.

Regulation 5 increases the dog handler's allowance.

Regulation 6 rectifies a drafting error in the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Full-Time) (Appointment and Conditions of Service) (Amendment) Regulations 1988.
