Made 25th January 1989

Coming into operation 1st March 1989

The Department of Education, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 3(2)(c) and (3) of the Education (Unrecognised Degrees) (Northern Ireland) Order 1988(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Education (Recognised Awards) Order (Northern Ireland) 1989 and shall come into operation on 1st March 1989.

Awards

2. The awards which are specified in Column 1 of the Schedule granted or to be granted by the person specified opposite in Column 2 thereof are hereby designated as recognised awards for the purposes of Article 3 of the Education (Unrecognised Degrees) (Northern Ireland) Order 1988.
