(Commencement) Order (Northern Ireland) 1989***Made 2nd August 1989*

The Department of the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 1(2) of the Motor Vehicles (Wearing of Rear Seat Belts by Children) (Northern Ireland) Order 1989(a) and paragraph 2(1) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974(b) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Wearing of Rear Seat Belts by Children) (Commencement) Order (Northern Ireland) 1989.

Commencement

2. The day appointed for the coming into operation of the Motor Vehicles (Wearing of Rear Seat Belts by Children) (Northern Ireland) Order 1989 shall be 1st September 1989.

This Order brings into operation on 1st September 1989 the Motor Vehicles (Wearing of Rear Seat Belts by Children) Order (Northern Ireland) 1989 which requires rear seat belts to be worn by children travelling in the rear of motor vehicles to which such seat belts are fitted.
