**The Criminal Justice (Evidence, Etc.) (1988 Order)  
(Commencement No. 1) Order (Northern Ireland) 1989**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Article 1(3) of the Criminal Justice (Evidence, Etc.) (Northern Ireland) Order 1988(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

*Citation*

1. This Order may be cited as the Criminal Justice (Evidence, Etc.) (1988 Order) (Commencement No. 1) Order (Northern Ireland) 1989.

*Appointed day*

2. The day appointed for the coming into operation of the provisions of the Criminal Justice (Evidence, Etc.) (Northern Ireland) Order 1988 not yet in operation, except Article 9, is 1st September 1989.
