

1989 No. 388**POLICE****Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions (Purchase of Increased Benefits) (Amendment) Regulations 1989**

Made 2nd October 1989

Coming into operation 1st November 1989

To be laid before Parliament

The Secretary of State, in pursuance of section 25 of the Police Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a), read with Articles 14 and 15 of the Superannuation (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(b), and after consulting, in accordance with section 34(2) of the said Act of 1970, the Police Authority for Northern Ireland and the Police Association for Northern Ireland, and, in accordance with section 2(3) of the Police Negotiating Board Act 1980(c), the Police Negotiating Board for the United Kingdom, hereby, with the concurrence of the Treasury, makes the following regulations:—

Citation, commencement and effect

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions (Purchase of Increased Benefits) (Amendment) Regulations 1989.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on 1st November 1989 and shall have effect as from 1st February 1988.

Interpretation

2. In these regulations any reference to the principal regulations is a reference to the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions (Purchase of Increased Benefits) Regulations 1988(d).

Lump sum payments

3. In regulation 4 of the principal regulations for the words “12 months” there shall be substituted the words “24 months” in each place where they occur.

Payment by periodical contributions

4. In regulation 5 of the principal regulations for the words “12 months” there shall be substituted the words “24 months” in each place where they occur.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations come into operation on 1st November 1989, and have effect as from 1st February 1988. They extend the period during which members of the Royal Ulster Constabulary, where eligible in accordance with regulation 2 of the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions (Purchase of Increased Benefits) Regulations 1988, may elect to purchase increased benefits under the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions Regulations 1988 up to the limit allowed by those regulations.

Retrospective effect is authorised by Articles 14 and 15 of the Superannuation (Northern Ireland) Order 1972.
