(Northern Ireland) 1989**

Made 9th October 1989

Coming into operation 30th October 1989

The Department of the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 65(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a), makes and confirms the following Bye-Laws:

Citation and commencement

1. These Bye-Laws may be cited as the Taxis (Strabane) (Amendment) Bye-Laws (Northern Ireland) 1989 and shall come into operation on 30th October 1989.

Bye-Laws amended

2. For the entry relating to Abercorn Square in the Schedule to the Taxis (Strabane) Bye-Laws (Northern Ireland) 1988(b) substitute—

“Abercorn Square	East side, from a point approximately 66 metres North of its junction with Church Street for a distance of approximately 16 metres in a Northerly direction.	3

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Bye-Laws.)

These Bye-Laws amend the Taxis (Strabane) Bye-Laws (Northern Ireland) 1988 by increasing from two to three the number of taxis which may stand at Abercorn Square, Strabane, and prescribing the new location of such taxi stand.
