## ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

**Off-Street Parking (Amendment No. 4) Bye-Laws  
(Northern Ireland) 1989**

*Made* . . . . . 28th November 1989

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 17th December 1989

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 105(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, makes the following bye-laws:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Off-Street Parking (Amendment No. 4) Bye-Laws (Northern Ireland) 1989 and shall come into operation on 17th December 1989.

*Amendment*

2. The Off-Street Parking Bye-Laws (Northern Ireland) 1983(b) shall be amended by the substitution for items 57 and 268 in Part I of the Schedule of the items in the Schedule to these bye-laws.
