**Diseases of Animals (Feeding Stuffs) (Amendment)
Order (Northern Ireland) 1989**

Made 28th December 1989

Coming into operation 31st December 1989

The Department of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 5(1) and 60(1) of the Diseases of Animals (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Diseases of Animals (Feeding Stuffs) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1989 and shall come into operation on 31st December 1989.

Amendment

2. Article 5 of the Diseases of Animals (Feeding Stuffs) Order (Northern Ireland) 1989(b) (which provides that that Order shall cease to have effect on 1st January 1990) shall be deleted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order, which is made under the Diseases of Animals (Northern Ireland) Order 1981, amends the Diseases of Animals (Feeding Stuffs) Order (Northern Ireland) 1989. It deletes from that Order the provision whereby the prohibition on the sale, supply and use of certain feeding stuffs for feeding to ruminating animals imposed by that Order will cease to have effect on 1st January 1990.
