Johne's Disease (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1989

Made 14th March 1989

Coming into operation 4th April 1989

The Department of Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 5(1), 10(6), 12, 14, 19(e) and (i) and 60(1) of the Diseases of Animals (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Johne's Disease (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1989 and shall come into operation on 4th April 1989.

Amendment of the Johne's Disease Order (Northern Ireland) 1976

2. In Article 2 of the Johne's Disease Order (Northern Ireland) 1976(b) for the definition of "animals" there shall be substituted —

“ “animals” means cattle, goats and all other ruminating animals except sheep;”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

The Johne's Disease Order (Northern Ireland) 1976 ("the principal Order") empowers the Department of Agriculture to deal with cases or suspected cases of Johne's disease and to prevent the spread of the disease. This Order amends the principal Order by removing sheep from the definition of animals controlled by that Order.
