**The Health and Medicines (1988 Order) (Commencement No. 2)
Order (Northern Ireland) 1989**

Made 21st March 1989

The Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 1(2) of the Health and Medicines (Northern Ireland) Order 1988(a), paragraph 2(1) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974(b) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Health and Medicines (1988 Order) (Commencement No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1989.

(2) In this Order—

“the 1972 Order” means the Health and Personal Social Services (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(c);

“the 1988 Order” means the Health and Medicines (Northern Ireland) Order 1988.

Days appointed

2.—(1) 22nd March 1989 is the day appointed for the coming into operation of each provision of the 1988 Order specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Order for the purposes specified in relation to it in column 3 of that Schedule.

(2) 1st April 1989 is the day appointed for the coming into operation of—

(a) each provision of the 1988 Order specified in Column 1 of Schedule 2 to this Order for the purposes specified in relation to it in Column 3 of that Schedule;

(b) Article 13 of the 1988 Order (repeals) so far as it relates to Article 14 of the Health and Personal Social Services and Public Health (Northern Ireland) Order 1986(d).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings into operation provisions of the Health and Medicines (Northern Ireland) Order 1988 relating to charges for dental treatment and appliances, to general ophthalmic services and to optical appliances. The provisions are brought into operation in stages, for some purposes on 22nd March 1989 and for remaining purposes on 1st April 1989.

NOTE AS TO EARLIER COMMENCEMENT ORDERS

(This note is not part of the Order.)

Article 7(1) of the Health and Medicines (Northern Ireland) Order 1988 in so far as it relates to the substitution of heads (i) and (ia) of sub-paragraph 1(a) of Schedule 15 to the Health and Personal Social Services (Northern Ireland) Order 1972, was brought into operation on 1st January 1989 by S.R. 1988/451 (C. 13)
