**CRIMINAL DAMAGE****Criminal Damage (Compensation)  
(Northern Ireland) (Amendment) Regulations 1990***Made* . . . . . 12th January 1990*Coming into operation* . . . . . 1st April 1990*To be laid before Parliament*

The Secretary of State, in pursuance of Articles 2(2), 7(2) and 21(2) of the Criminal Damage (Compensation) (Northern Ireland) Order 1977(a), hereby makes the following regulations:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. These regulations may be cited as the Criminal Damage (Compensation) (Northern Ireland) (Amendment) Regulations 1990 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1990.

*Interpretation*

2. In these regulations “the principal regulations” means the Criminal Damage (Compensation) (Northern Ireland) Regulations 1978(b).

*Amendment to the principal regulations*

3. Regulations 3(2) and 4(1) of and the Schedule to the principal regulations are hereby revoked.
