**Horse Racing (Charges on Bookmakers) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1990**

Made 13th August 1990

Coming into operation 25th September 1990

*To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 3(3) of
Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974*

The Department of Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 9(1) of the Horse Racing (Northern Ireland) Order 1990(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, after consultation with such organisations as appear to the Department to substantially represent the interests of bookmakers, and with the approval of the Department of Finance and Personnel, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Horse Racing (Charges on Bookmakers) Order (Northern Ireland) 1990 and shall come into operation on 25th September 1990.

(2) In this Order “the Order of 1990” means the Horse Racing (Northern Ireland) Order 1990.

Charges on bookmakers

2. The charges to be paid to the Department under Article 9 of the Order of 1990 for the benefit of the Fund shall be—

- (a) £19 in the case of every person to whom Article 9(1)(a) of the Order of 1990 applies;
- (b) £275 in the case of every person to whom Article 9(1)(b) of the Order of 1990 applies.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

Article 9(1) of the Horse Racing (Northern Ireland) Order 1990 provides for charges to be paid to the Department of Agriculture by persons who intend to apply for or in respect of bookmakers' and bookmaking office licences.

This Order specifies the charges payable as follows—

- (a) £19 by persons, other than those mentioned in (b) below, who intend to apply for the grant or renewal of a bookmaker's licence; and
- (b) £275 by persons who intend to apply for the grant or renewal of a bookmaking office licence or to have the provisional grant of a bookmaking office licence declared final.
