**The Social Security (Industrial Injuries and Diseases)
(Miscellaneous Provisions) (Amendment) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1990**

Made 6th February 1990

Coming into operation 11th February 1990

The Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 84(1) of the Social Security (Northern Ireland) Order 1986(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Industrial Injuries and Diseases) (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1990 and shall come into operation on 11th February 1990.

(2) In these regulations “the principal regulations” means the Social Security (Industrial Injuries and Diseases) (Miscellaneous Provisions) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1986(b).

Amendment of regulation 13 of the principal regulations

2. Regulation 13 of the principal regulations (delayed claims) shall cease to have effect.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations, which come into operation on 11th February 1990, amend the Social Security (Industrial Injuries and Diseases) (Miscellaneous Provisions) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1986 ("the principal regulations").

Regulation 2 provides that regulation 13 of the principal regulations (which relates to claims made on or after 19th November 1986 in relation to accidents which occurred before, or to diseases where the date of onset was before, 19th November 1986) shall cease to have effect from 11th February 1990.
