## NURSING HOMES

**Nursing Homes (Registration Fees and Lasers Control)  
(Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1990**

*Made* . . . . . 11th December 1990

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 14th January 1991

The Department of Health and Social Services in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 1(2) and 6(1)(e) of the Nursing Homes and Nursing Agencies Act (Northern Ireland) 1971(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

*Citation and commencement*

1. These regulations may be cited as the Nursing Homes (Registration Fees and Lasers Control) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1990 and shall come into operation on 14th January 1991.

*Amendment*

2. The Nursing Homes (Registration Fees and Lasers Control) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1986(b) shall be amended as follows—

(a) in regulation 2(1) for “£600.” there shall be substituted “£678.”; and

(b) in regulation 2(2) for “£380.” there shall be substituted “£410.”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These regulations amend regulation 2 of the Nursing Homes (Registration Fees and Licences Control) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1986 so as to increase the fees, associated with the registration of nursing homes, payable to a Health and Social Services Board.

The fee to accompany an application for registration is increased from £600 to £678. The fee to accompany an application on a proposed change of manager is increased from £380 to £410.
