**Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Part-Time)
(Appointment and Conditions of Service)
(Amendment No. 2) Regulations 1990**

Made 30th November 1990

Coming into operation 22nd January 1991

To be laid before Parliament

The Secretary of State, in pursuance of section 26 of the Police Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a), read with section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962(b), and after consulting, in accordance with section 34(2) of the said Act of 1970, the Police Authority and the Police Association, hereby with the concurrence of the Treasury makes the following regulations:—

Citation, operation and effect

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Part-Time) (Appointment and Conditions of Service) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 1990.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on 22nd January 1991 but shall have effect as on and from 1st September 1989 for the purposes of regulation 3.

Interpretation

2. In these regulations any reference to the principal regulations is a reference to the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Part-Time) (Appointment and Conditions of Service) Regulations 1988(c).

Pay

3. There shall be substituted for regulation 18 of the principal regulations—

“18. The rate of pay for any member for each hour of duty actually performed is £4.74.”

4. In Schedule 3 to the principal regulations for the Table headed ‘Women’ there shall be substituted the Table set out in the Schedule.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations amend the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Part-Time) (Appointments and Conditions of Service) Regulations 1988 (the principal regulations) with effect, as provided by regulation 1, from 22nd January 1991 but for the purposes of regulation 3 shall have effect as on and from 1st September 1989. Retrospection is authorised by section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962.

Regulation 4 corrects an anomaly in the principal regulations by providing for the issue of slacks to female members of the force.
