**The Sheep Annual Premium (Amendment No. 2) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1990**

Made 19th December 1990

Coming into operation 15th January 1991

The Department of Agriculture, being a Department designated(a) for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972(b) in relation to the common agricultural policy of the European Community, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by that section and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Sheep Annual Premium (Amendment No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1990 and shall come into operation on 15th January 1991.

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954(c) shall apply to these Regulations as it applies to a Measure of the Northern Ireland Assembly.

Amendment of the Sheep Annual Premium Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987

3. For regulation 4(2) of the Sheep Annual Premium Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987(d) there shall be substituted—

“(2) An application for a premium in respect of a marketing year shall be delivered to the competent authority on or after 28th January in the calendar year in which the marketing year commences and not later than 27th February in that calendar year or if 27th February is a Saturday, Sunday or public holiday, the next following working day.”.

Revocations

4. The Sheep Annual Premium (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1989(e) and the Sheep Annual Premium (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1990(f) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations amend the Sheep Annual Premium Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987 ("the principal Regulations"). The principal Regulations implement Commission Regulation (EEC) No. 3007/84 as amended by Commission Regulation (EEC) No. 3378/85 and Commission Regulation (EEC) No. 3984/89 which lays down detailed rules for the application for payment of a sheep annual premium to sheepmeat producers. The principal Regulations specify that applications for premium in respect of a marketing year must reach the Department of Agriculture between the 15th of January in the calendar year in which the marketing year commences and the 14th of February of that calendar year. These regulations amend the principal Regulations to specify that applications for premium in respect of a marketing year must reach the Department of Agriculture between the 28th of January in the calendar year in which the marketing year commences and the 27th of February in that calendar year.
