ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

**One-Way Traffic (Belfast) (Amendment) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1990**

Made 23rd February 1990

Coming into operation 15th April 1990

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the One-Way Traffic (Belfast) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1990 and shall come into operation on 15th April 1990.

Amendment

2. In column 2 in the item relating to Skipper Street in Schedule 2 to the One-Way Traffic (Belfast) Order (Northern Ireland) 1986(b) for the words "Northerly from High Street." substitute "Southerly from Waring Street."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the provisions of the One-Way Traffic (Belfast) Order (Northern Ireland) 1986.

The amendment provides for a reversal of the direction of traffic in Skipper Street, Belfast.

Any person who acts in contravention of the Order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (£400).

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be erected on the road.
