**Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Part-Time)  
(Appointment and Conditions of Service)  
(Amendment) Regulations 1990**

*Made* . . . . . 27th February 1990

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 1st April 1990

*To be laid before Parliament*

The Secretary of State, in pursuance of section 26 of the Police Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a), and after consulting, in accordance with section 34(2) of the said Act of 1970, the Police Authority and the Police Association, hereby with the concurrence of the Treasury makes the following regulations:—

*Citation, commencement and effect*

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Part-Time) (Appointment and Conditions of Service) (Amendment) Regulations 1990.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on 1st April 1990.

*Interpretation*

2. In these regulations any reference to the principal regulations is a reference to the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Part-Time) (Appointment and Conditions of Service) Regulations 1988(b).

*Restriction on payment of allowances*

3. In regulation 22 of the principal regulations, there shall be inserted at the beginning of paragraph (2) the words “Subject to paragraph (3)” and there shall be inserted after paragraph (2) the following paragraph:—

“(3) A member of the rank of reserve superintendent who is required to travel by train in the execution of his duty shall be entitled to travel in first-class accommodation and to be reimbursed his expenses accordingly.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These regulations amend the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Part-Time) (Appointments and Conditions of Service) Regulations 1988 (the principal regulations).

Regulation 3 provides for members of the rank of reserve superintendent to be reimbursed the cost of first-class rail travel on duty.
