Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Criminal Damage (Compensation) (Northern Ireland) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1990 and shall come into operation on 31st March 1990.

Revocation

2. The Criminal Damage (Compensation) (Northern Ireland) (Amendment) Regulations 1990(b) are hereby revoked.

Criminal Damage EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations revoke the Criminal Damage (Compensation) (Northern Ireland) (Amendment) Regulations 1990 before they come into operation. The Criminal Damage (Compensation) (Northern Ireland) (Amendment) Regulations 1990 provided for the revocation of regulations 3(2) and 4(1) of and the Schedule to the Criminal Damage (Compensation) (Northern Ireland) Regulations 1978 which prescribe respectively the form for the preliminary notice of intention to apply for compensation and the form for the application for compensation under the Criminal Damage (Compensation) (Northern Ireland) Order 1977 but omitted to prescribe forms in their place.
