**TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT****Redundancy Payments (Merchant Seamen Exclusion)  
(Revocation) Order (Northern Ireland) 1991**

The Department of Economic Development(a), in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 26(5)(a) of the Contracts of Employment and Redundancy Payments Act (Northern Ireland) 1965(b) and every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Redundancy Payments (Merchant Seamen Exclusion) (Revocation) Order (Northern Ireland) 1991 and shall come into operation on 26th July 1991.

*Revocation*

2. The Redundancy Payments (Merchant Seamen Exclusion) Order (Northern Ireland) 1973(c) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order revokes the Redundancy Payments (Merchant Seamen Exclusion) Order (Northern Ireland) 1973 ("the 1973 Order") which excluded certain employments as a merchant seaman from the redundancy payments provisions of the Contracts of Employment and Redundancy Payments Act (Northern Ireland) 1965. The effect of the revocation is to apply those provisions to merchant seamen to whom the 1973 Order applied.
