**Off-Street Parking (Amendment No. 6) Bye-Laws
(Northern Ireland) 1991**

Made 25th June 1991

Coming into operation 7th July 1991

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 2(2)(a) and 105(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(b) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, makes the following bye-laws:—

Citation and commencement

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Off-Street Parking (Amendment No. 6) Bye-Laws (Northern Ireland) 1991 and shall come into operation on 7th July 1991.

Amendment

2. The Off-Street Parking Bye-Laws (Northern Ireland) 1983(c) shall be amended by the addition to Part I of the Schedule of the items in the Schedule.
