**The Insolvency Practitioners (Recognised Professional Bodies)
Order (Northern Ireland) 1991**

Made 9th July 1991

Coming into operation 5th August 1991

Whereas it appears to the Department of Economic Development (“the Department”) that the bodies specified in the Schedule fall within Article 350(2) of the Insolvency (Northern Ireland) Order 1989 (“the Order of 1989”)(a):

Now, therefore, the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 350(1) and (4) of the Order of 1989 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Insolvency Practitioners (Recognised Professional Bodies) Order (Northern Ireland) 1991 and shall come into operation on 5th August 1991.

Recognised professional bodies

2. The bodies specified in the Schedule are hereby declared to be recognised professional bodies for the purposes of Article 350 of the Order of 1989.

This Order declares the bodies specified in its Schedule to be recognised professional bodies for the purposes of Article 350 of the Insolvency (Northern Ireland) Order 1989. Membership of such a body will, subject to the Insolvency (Northern Ireland) Order 1989, entitle an individual to act as an insolvency practitioner where he is permitted to do so by or under the rules of the body concerned.
