**One-Way Traffic (Ballymoney) (Amendment) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1991**

Made 13th September 1991

Coming into operation 25th October 1991

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 2(2)(b) and 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the One-Way Traffic (Ballymoney) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1991 and shall come into operation on 25th October 1991.

Amendment

2. The Schedule to the One-Way Traffic (Ballymoney) Order (Northern Ireland) 1984(c) shall be amended by the addition thereto of the following item—

<i>Column 1</i>	<i>Column 2</i>
Castle Street car park perimeter road	Clockwise from its south-westerly junction with Castle Street

This Order amends the provisions of the One-Way Traffic (Ballymoney) Order (Northern Ireland) 1984.

The amendment provides for the introduction of a one-way traffic system in Castle Street car park perimeter road, Ballymoney.

Any person who acts in contravention of the Order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (£400).

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be erected on the road.
