Planning Applications (Exemption from Publication) Order (Northern Ireland) 1991

24th October 1991 Made Coming into operation . 2nd December 1991

The Department of the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 2(2)(a) and 21(2) of the Planning (Northern Ireland) Order 1991(b) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Planning Applications (Exemption from Publication) Order (Northern Ireland) 1991 and shall come into operation on 2nd December 1991.

Exempted applications

2. The provisions of Article 21(1) of the Planning (Northern Ireland) Order 1991 (publication of notices of planning applications) shall not apply to development of any class specified in the Schedule except where the development is in a conservation area.

Class A

The enlargement, improvement or alteration of a dwelling house.

Class B

The provision within the curtilage of a dwelling house of any building or enclosure for a purpose incidental to the enjoyment of the dwelling house or the enlargement, improvement or alteration of such a building or enclosure.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

Article 21(2) of the Planning (Northern Ireland) Order 1991 allows the Department to specify classes of development for which notice of application for planning permission need not be published in the press.

Article 2 and the Schedule to this Order specify classes of development which need not be published so long as the development is not in a conservation area.
