## ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Road Vehicles Lighting (Amendment) Regulations  
(Northern Ireland) 1991

Made . . . . . 24th December 1991

Coming into operation . . . . . 3rd February 1992

The Department of the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 2(2)(a), 28(1), 49(2) and 218(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(b) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Regulations:

*Citation and commencement*

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Vehicles Lighting (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1991 and shall come into operation on 3rd February 1992.

*Regulations amended*

2. In regulation 52(3)(c) (distinctive lamps on certain vehicles) of the Road Vehicles Lighting Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1969(c) at the beginning insert "except in the case of a motor vehicle used for police purposes".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These Regulations further amend the Road Vehicles Lighting Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1969 so as to exempt motor vehicles used for police purposes from the requirement that when carrying more than one lamp showing a blue light at least one of those lamps shall be visible from any point at a reasonable distance from the vehicle.
