**The Child Benefit (Different Rates) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1991**

Made 11th March 1991

Coming into operation 8th April 1991

The Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 7(3) of the Child Benefit (Northern Ireland) Order 1975(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Child Benefit (Different Rates) Order (Northern Ireland) 1991 and shall come into operation on 8th April 1991.

Day on which child benefit becomes payable at different rates

2. The day on which child benefit under the Child Benefit (Northern Ireland) Order 1975 shall become payable at the rate specified in regulation 2(1)(a) of the Child Benefit and Social Security (Fixing and Adjustment of Rates) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976(b) is 8th April 1991.
