## CINEMAS

**Cinema Licence Fees (Variation) Order  
(Northern Ireland) 1992**

*Made* . . . . . 27th March 1992

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 1st May 1992

The Department of the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 2(2) and 5(8) of the Cinemas (Northern Ireland) Order 1991(a) (“the Order”) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Cinema Licence Fees (Variation) Order (Northern Ireland) 1992 and shall come into operation on 1st May 1992.

*Variation of fees*

2. Article 5(7) of the Order (grant, renewal and transfer of licence or consent) shall be amended as follows—

- (1) In sub-paragraph (a) for “£173·50” substitute “£600·00”.
- (2) In sub-paragraph (b) for “£58” substitute “£200·00” and for “£173·50” substitute “£600·00”.
- (3) In sub-paragraph (c) for “£35” substitute “£120·00”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order increases the maximum fees which a district council may charge for the grant, renewal or transfer of cinema licences.

Article 2 shows the new maximum fees chargeable.

The average percentage increase in the fees is 245%.
