ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

One-Way Traffic (Holywood) Order (Northern Ireland) 1992

Made 18th May 1992

Coming into operation 29th June 1992

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 2(2)(b) and 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the One-Way Traffic (Holywood) Order (Northern Ireland) 1992 and shall come into operation on 29th June 1992.

Prohibition

2. A person shall not, except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on Ean Hill, Holywood, other than in a north-westerly direction from Church View.

This Order provides for the introduction of a one-way system of traffic in Ean Hill, Hollywood.

Any person who acts in contravention of the Order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (£400).

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be erected on the road.
