DOGS

Dogs (Exemption) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1992

Made 27th January 1992

Coming into operation 21st February 1992

The Department of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 5(f) of the Dogs (Northern Ireland) Order 1983(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Dogs (Exemption) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1992 and shall come into operation on 21st February 1992.

Exemption

2. Any deaf or hearing impaired person who keeps a dog, which was supplied or trained by Hearing Dogs for the Deaf, wholly or mainly for his guidance shall be prescribed for the purposes of Article 5(f) (exemption from the requirement to have a dog licence) of the Dogs (Northern Ireland) Order 1983.
