**Secondary Schools (Admissions Criteria) (Amendment)
Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1992**

Made 27th July 1992

Coming into operation 1st September 1992

The Department of Education, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 38(6) of the Education Reform (Northern Ireland) Order 1989(a) and every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Secondary Schools (Admissions Criteria) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1992 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1992.

Interpretation

2. In these Regulations—

“key stage 2” means the second key stage as defined by Article 5(6)(b) of the Education Reform (Northern Ireland) Order 1989.

Amendment of the Secondary Schools (Admissions Criteria) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1990

3. The Secondary Schools (Admissions Criteria) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1990(b) shall be amended as follows—

at the end of regulation 5(b) for “.” there shall be substituted “;” and there shall be added the following—

“(c) the outcome of the pilot assessments determined for a pupil in key stage 2 in the 1992/93 school year in accordance with arrangements established by the Northern Ireland Schools Examinations and Assessment Council.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Secondary Schools (Admissions Criteria) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1990 by prohibiting all grant-aided secondary schools from including in their admissions criteria the outcome of the pilot assessment arrangements for a pupil in key stage 2 in the 1992/93 school year.
