Legal Aid (Scope) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1993

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 10(2) and 27 of the Legal Aid, Advice and Assistance (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and now vested in him(b) hereby makes the following Regulations—

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Legal Aid (Scope) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1993 and shall come into operation on 30th April 1993.

Amendment to the Order

- 2. In paragraph 3 of Part I of Schedule 1 to the Legal Aid Advice and Assistance (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(c), after sub-paragraph (g) there shall be added the following sub-paragraph—
 - "(h) appeals under Article 22 of the Child Support (Northern Ireland)
 Order 1991, so far as such appeals are to be made to a court of
 summary jurisdiction by virtue of Article 2 of the Child Support
 Appeals (Jurisdiction of Courts) Order (Northern Ireland) 1993,
 and proceedings under Article 28 of the Child Support (Northern
 Ireland) Order 1991".
