The Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 1(2) to (5) of the Child Support (Northern Ireland) Order 1991(a) and paragraph 2(1) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974(b) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:

*Citation*

1. This order may be cited as the Child Support (1991 Order) (Commencement No. 3 and Transitional Provisions) (Amendment No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1993.

*Amendment of the Child Support (1991 Order) (Commencement No. 3 and Transitional Provisions) Order*

2. In the Schedule to the Child Support (1991 Order) (Commencement No. 3 and Transitional Provisions) Order (Northern Ireland) 1992(c) after paragraph 1(2) there shall be added the following sub-paragraph—

“(3) For the purposes of paragraph 4, from and including 5th April 1993, an application for a maintenance order is pending before a court if, before that date, a summons has been issued in accordance with the Illegitimate Children (Affiliation Orders) Act (Northern Ireland) 1924(d).”.
