## ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

**Public Service Vehicles (Licence Fees) (Amendment) Regulations  
(Northern Ireland) 1993**

*Made* . . . . . 16th September 1993

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 1st November 1993

The Department of the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 61(1), 66(1) and 218(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and with the approval of the Department of Finance and Personnel(b) as regards regulation 2, makes the following Regulations:

*Citation and commencement*

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Service Vehicles (Licence Fees) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1993 and shall come into operation on 1st November 1993.

*Amendment of the 1985 Regulations*

2. In paragraphs 1(c) and 2(c) of Schedule 7 to the Public Service Vehicles Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1985(c) for “£28·30” substitute “£29·20”.
