## ELECTRICITY

**Northern Ireland Electricity (Dissolution) Order  
(Northern Ireland) 1993**

*Made* . . . . . 1st October 1993

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 15th November 1993

The Department of Economic Development, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 86(4) of the Electricity (Northern Ireland) Order 1992(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, after consultation with Northern Ireland Electricity and its successor companies and being satisfied that nothing further remains to be done by Northern Ireland Electricity (whether under Schedule 13 to that Order or otherwise), hereby makes the following Order:

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Northern Ireland Electricity (Dissolution) Order (Northern Ireland) 1993 and shall come into operation on 15th November 1993.

*Dissolution of Northern Ireland Electricity*

2. Northern Ireland Electricity shall be dissolved on the day this Order comes into operation.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order dissolves Northern Ireland Electricity, which was established under Article 4 of the Electricity Supply (Northern Ireland) Order 1972. The assets and liabilities of Northern Ireland Electricity were transferred to nominated successor companies on 1st April 1992 (see S.R. 1992 No. 87) under Article 69(4) of the Electricity (Northern Ireland) Order 1992. Article 86 of that Order provides for Northern Ireland Electricity to continue in existence after the transfer date and, together with provisions in Schedule 13 to that Order, specifies certain duties to be carried out as necessary by it. Those duties, so far as necessary and as applying to Northern Ireland Electricity, have been discharged.
