ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

**Control of Traffic (Belfast) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1993**

Made 22nd November 1993

Coming into operation 31st December 1993

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS one objection has been received and duly considered and no representation has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Control of Traffic (Belfast) Order (Northern Ireland) 1993 and shall come into operation on 31st December 1993.

Prohibition of left-hand turn

2.—(1) A person shall not, except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit a vehicle travelling in a northerly direction along the carriageway of Ravenhill Road, Belfast, to make a left-hand turn into Albertbridge Road.

(2) In paragraph (1) “carriageway” does not include the slip-road leading to the junction of Ravenhill Road with Albertbridge Road.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order prohibits vehicles travelling in a northerly direction along the main carriageway of Ravenhill Road, Belfast, from making a left-hand-turn into Albertbridge Road.

Any person who acts in contravention of the Order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (£400).

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be erected on Ravenhill Road.
