The Department of Finance and Personnel(**a**), in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 2(2), 7(1) and 27(4) of the Rates (Northern Ireland) Order 1977(**b**) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Rates (Regional Rate) Order (Northern Ireland) 1993 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1993.

Regional rate

2. The regional rate for the year ending 31st March 1994 shall be 145.98 pence in the pound.

Reduction of regional rate on dwellings

3. The amount by which the normal regional rate fixed for the year ending 31st March 1994 under Article 2 is to be reduced for the purposes of paragraph (2) and paragraph (3) of Article 27 of the Rates (Northern Ireland) Order 1977 shall be 80 pence.
