**ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES**

**Temporary Speed Limit (Motorway M22) Order  
(Northern Ireland) 1993**

*Made* . . . . . 24th February 1993

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 19th April 1993

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment is satisfied that it is desirable in the interests of safety to restrict the speed of motor vehicles on part of the Motorway M22;

AND WHEREAS the Department has published notice of its intention in compliance with Article 51(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

NOW THEREFORE the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 51(1) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Temporary Speed Limit (Motorway M22) Order (Northern Ireland) 1993 and shall come into operation on 19th April 1993.

*Application and duration of speed limit*

2. The driving of motor vehicles at a speed greater than 50 miles per hour on both carriageways of the Motorway M22, from its junction with the Motorway M2 to its junction with Dunsilly Interchange, Dunsilly, Antrim, is prohibited for a period of 4 months from 18th April 1993.

*(This note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order prohibits the driving of motor vehicles on both carriageways of the Motorway M22, from its junction with the Motorway M2 to its junction with Dunsilly Interchange, Dunsilly, Antrim, at more than 50 miles per hour for a period of 4 months commencing on 19th April 1993 in the interests of safety.

Any person who acts in contravention of the Order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (£400).

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be erected on the road.
