**The Protected Rights (Transfer Payment) (Amendment)
Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1994**

Made 5th July 1994

Coming into operation 29th July 1994

The Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 24(2)(b) of the Pension Schemes (Northern Ireland) Act 1993(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Protected Rights (Transfer Payment) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1994 and shall come into operation on 29th July 1994.

(2) The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954(b) shall apply to these regulations as it applies to a Measure of the Assembly.

Amendment of Schedule 1 to the Protected Rights (Transfer Payment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987

2. In Schedule 1 to the Protected Rights (Transfer Payment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987(c) at the end of paragraphs 2, 3 and 4 there shall be added “or the member has previously been a member of the receiving scheme”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations amend the Protected Rights (Transfer Payment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987. They make provision so as to allow, in certain circumstances, the transfer of a person's protected rights into an occupational pension scheme of which that person has previously been a member even though he is not entering employment in relation to that scheme.
