**One-Way Traffic (Belfast) (Amendment No. 3) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1994**

Made 23rd August 1994

Coming into operation 4th October 1994

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection or representation has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the One-Way Traffic (Belfast) (Amendment No. 3) Order (Northern Ireland) 1994 and shall come into operation on 4th October 1994.

Amendment

2. In Schedule 2 to the One-Way Traffic (Belfast) Order (Northern Ireland) 1986(b) the entry relating to Prince's Street, from its junction with Ann Street to its junction with Marlborough Street, shall be deleted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the provisions of the One-Way Traffic (Belfast) Order (Northern Ireland) 1986.

The effect of the Order is to re-introduce a two-way traffic system in Prince's Street, Belfast, between its junction with Ann Street and its junction with Marlborough Street.
